- The Registrar's Office will notify you of your CIU email account activation.** Your CIU email will be the official method of communication between CIU and you. Access your email by clicking the Student Webmail link on my.ciu.edu Student section. This will take you to a Gmail log-in page. Enter your entire email address (username@mailbox.ciu.edu) and my.ciu.edu password to log-in, not just your username.

Registering for Classes
